    - o identity of the person whom assumed custody / control
  - CVI that accompanied dog when it entered or left the licensee's custody / control
  - Vaccination information
  - Observation information
  - Treatment that occurred & who administered the healthcare
  - Breed registration records kept, if applicable

### DOGS SOLD/TRANSFERRED/ADOPTED - CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) REQUIRED S. ATCP 16.16

### Facility notes / comments:

Dogs within the facility are kept within two separate buildings; licensee's residence and a detached garage building. The indoor spaces have heating controls, A/C, and artificial & natural lighting.

*PRIMARY ENCLOSURES* – The primary housing for dogs is a temperature-controlled garage building. Within the space are five (5) enclosures that may serve as an indoor primary enclosure for 1-2 adult dogs or as a whelping enclosure for a dam & her litter of puppies. Each enclosure is constructed of kennel panels upon a cement floor (epoxy coated). Blankets are provided for bedding. Each enclosure has a floor area of approximately 50 ft<sup>2</sup> (dimension: 5' x 10'). Dogs are rotated into the yard multiple times a day for exercise; during appropriate weather dogs may be kept outside for extended periods of time. Dogs may also be rotated into the residence and cared for as house hold pets.

*WHELPING / NURSERY ENCLOSURES* – Dams whelp and nurse their litter within a large enclosure constructed of kennel panels. Each enclosure has a floor area of approximately 50 ft<sup>2</sup> (dimension: 5' x 10'). Plastic pools are used for a whelping box. Weaned puppies are then transitioned into larger pens constructed of x-pen panels.

*EXERCISE* – Dogs are let outside several times a day for exercise. Dogs are allowed to roam the yard. During appropriate weather dogs may be kept outside for extended periods of time. Dogs may wear e-collars when necessary to keep within the yard.

*OUTDOOR FACILITIES* – Yard surrounding the garage building and residence.

### Inspection summary:

#### **February 6, 2023**

(11:30 am) – Colin Benell (Companion Animal Inspector, DATCP) conducted a pre-licensing inspection of the dog breeding facility and dog records at 1195 Short Drive in River Falls, WI. Benell was accompanied & assisted by Brianna Rasmusen (Owner, Kinnickinnic Goldendoodles, LLC).

Dog inventory: 7 adult/ sub-adult dogs, 8 puppies

*Based upon the results of the pre-licensing inspection a FULL STATUS license is recommended.*

**Deficiencies:** NONE

### Inspection result:

Based upon the findings from the pre-licensing inspection a FULL status license is recommended to be issued.



**Discussion with KGD:**

- The minimum age requirement and certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) requirements were discussed. KGD stated puppies will not be sold before 7 weeks of age. Puppies have been examined by a veterinarian prior to sale. Benell explained the CVI requirement and that each customer is to get a copy of a CVI upon purchase. Benell explained the Wisconsin Intra-state DS CVI.
- License renewal and inspection procedures were discussed.
- KGD was made aware of the requirement to post the license and most recent inspection report in accordance with ATCP 16.12(5)(b) and ATCP 16.02(4)(a).
- KGD was made aware of the requirement to post the license number on any advertisements in accordance with ATCP 16.02(5).
- Import requirements were discussed under ATCP 10.80(1).
- B. Canis was discussed and educational materials were provided.

**Notes:**

- Benell reviewed the record keeping requirements with KGD and provided recommendations for maintaining such records. Paper records were being kept. Puppies recently sold were at least 7 weeks of age when sold. All indoor and outdoor facilities were observed to be in good condition and clean. All housing had adequate sanitation, lighting, ventilation, and air temperature. All dogs on premises were observed to be in good body condition and appeared to have adequate food, water, inanimate enrichment, and exercise on the date of the inspection.
