The puppy is sold to the purchaser on the following conditions:

- The puppy has been reared in a home environment and has been dewormed. The breeder has followed the recommended vaccination protocol for puppies. The puppy is believed to be in good health.
- The purchaser understands and is in agreement that the down payment of \$600.00 to aquire a Kinnickinnic Goldendoodle is NON-REFUNDABLE. Once the buyer picks up their puppy, they assume responsibility for the puppy and ownership is transferred to them. The puppy fee (remaining balance +tax) becomes NON-REFUNDABLE at that time.
- The purchaser is strongly advised to have the puppy vet checked within four to eight weeks of them picking up their puppy. If the purchasers veterinarian officially certifies on their stationary that there is a genetic disease detected and verified through testing, which makes the puppy unfit for the purchasers home, the purchaser has the option to contact the breeder within ninety days of the puppy's adoption and discuss the breeder accepting the puppy back in order to find it a suitable home. The purchaser gives the breeder permission to speak directly with their veterinarian for diagnosis information. Official diagnosis must be emailed or mailed to the breeder. The breeder will not pay expenses incurred in the return of a puppy, any veterinary bills occurred by the buyer, nor accept any claim for distress caused by the return.
- The breeder has enquired of the purchaser his or her past experience with dogs and, in particular with this specific breed, and on the basis of the information received is willing to place a puppy with the purchaser. The breeder has pointed out to the purchaser the main conditions the breed is prone to and the health schemes followed to reduce the risk of such conditions. Every puppy is an individual and the breeder cannot be held responsible should conditions, genetic or otherwise, develop later in life. The breeder is also not responsible for any accidental injuries or lifestyle induced diseases.
- The purchaser agrees to have dog spay/neutered when appropriate, usually between 12-24 months old or when full maturity and frame size is achieved. The breeder has included information regarding the possible side effects of early spay/neuter in the puppy's going home material. ONLY EXCEPTION to spay/neuter requirement: Breeding Rights Fee (\$1000) has been paid in full at the time of adoption. Proof of spay/neuter must be submitted to breeder.
- The purchaser agrees that the dog will be kept in appropriate conditions for its welfare and health. It will be fed on a suitable diet for its age and condition and have appropriate exercise. It will receive all necessary veterinary care to maintain its physical good health.
- The dog will be kept under appropriate control and will not be neglected or maltreated in any way. The purchaser attests that he or she has not been banned from keeping a dog or any other animal by any legal court order.
- If circumstances occur where it becomes necessary to re-home the dog, the breeder must first be notified and given an opportunity to take back the dog and find a suitable home for it if a new family or rescue is needed. Any refund is up to breeder discretion and will largely depend on the age of the puppy when it is returned to the breeder, how long it takes to find a new home and what rehoming fee, if any, is received by the breeder.
